

## Afternair Tests by Karl Haefner

I (Grunt) have a bit of a personal problem. I have hair growing on my penis. It really isn't much of a problem for me, but I am sure my lovers find it a little difficult to deal with in certain situations, if you catch my drift. Therefore, I started looking for a solution. Since I cut my face when I shave, that is not an option for a more sensitive area. My search of the internet turned up many men who actually use Nair® despite the package's warnings against application to the genitals. These same men complained about the burning sensation they got from its use, and that is when a light bulb went on above my head. They were undoubtedly experiencing a chemical burn. Modern aromatherapy got its start from treatment of a laboratory burn with lavender oil. Why not use essential oils to treat a chemical burn after Nair® use. That is how Afternair Aftershave was born.

Does it work? I cannot tell you. To test the product, I decided to go ahead and use Nair® myself. I chose the mousse style of Nair®. To test the product itself, I applied it per directions to my right forearm. I left the product on twice as long (8 minutes) as recommended for arm application, and I removed it with a damp cloth as per the package directions. Unfortunately, I received no chemical burn whatsoever. This did give me the balls, pun intended, to attempt application to my genital.

Not wanting to overstep, I applied the Nair® to the right side of my scrotum and penis. There was no initial pain on application. The package said to leave the product on the bikini area for 12 minutes, so that is how long I allowed the product to sit. After about 4 minutes, I started receiving some burning in my perineal area. I shifted my body so my butt was above my balls. The sensation then went away. There was no more discomfort, other than my new leaned-over sitting position, for the remainder of the application. The product and hair, untrimmed at that, then wiped away cleanly. I experienced no burning sensation. After about 30 minutes, there was some minor tingling on my scrotum and a continued irritation of my perineum, but nothing intolerable.

On the second day, I decided to try to complete the task, so I performed the same procedure on my left testicle. I had some tingling in my left groin as well as on my right testicle. Similar to yesterday, the stinging on the left went away after 4 minutes. However, the right continued to sting the entire 12 minutes. There was even some pin-like pain when I used the washcloth to gently rub off the hair. The first thing I tried was simply rinsing with cold water. That made the pain worse and more constant, so I was in a position to try our Afternair. I applied Afternair to the sites that exhibited pain, but this was unsuccessful. I then spread the Afternair into my perineal region. This

alleviated some of the pain and gave me a clue that the pain might be referred from other locations. Based on this information, I applied Afternair to my left testicle. The pain was calmed but not completely alleviated. However, by the time I wrote this paragraph, the pain was completely gone. I will have to add instructions to Afternair to apply to entire penile area no matter where the pain is.

After about 2 hours, light pain returned. I reapplied Afternair to the entire scrotal area. The pain subsided within a few minutes, and I was pain free for approximately 7 hours. A very light discomfort returned, not really a pain. I decided anyway to apply Afternair for a third time even though the pain was completely tolerable. This resulted in the worst pain I experienced this entire process. The pain again subsided within minutes after application. Because of this, I would recommend only two applications of Afternair to a potential chemical burn. The next day, I visually inspected the skin. Although there was no pain, there were several blood-colored spots indicative of a burn.

Those deciding to use Nair® on their private parts should follow some recommendations: Make sure you perform the procedure when you know you can be unclothed for several hours; you don't want to rub the bald boys against rough cloth their first day out. Do it all at once or leave some time between applications; waiting one day to finish the job is, in my experience, not enough time for the previous spot to recover. Keep Nair® away from the perineal area; that's the space from the scrotum to the anus. The scrotum skin will tighten a lot; this could be the source of more pain not covered in our formula. My experiences will differ from yours; there are a lot of men on the internet reporting intolerable pain when using Nair® for this purpose. While I still have some touchup work to do, I am initially happy with the results of the procedure and the initial efficacy of Afternair.
